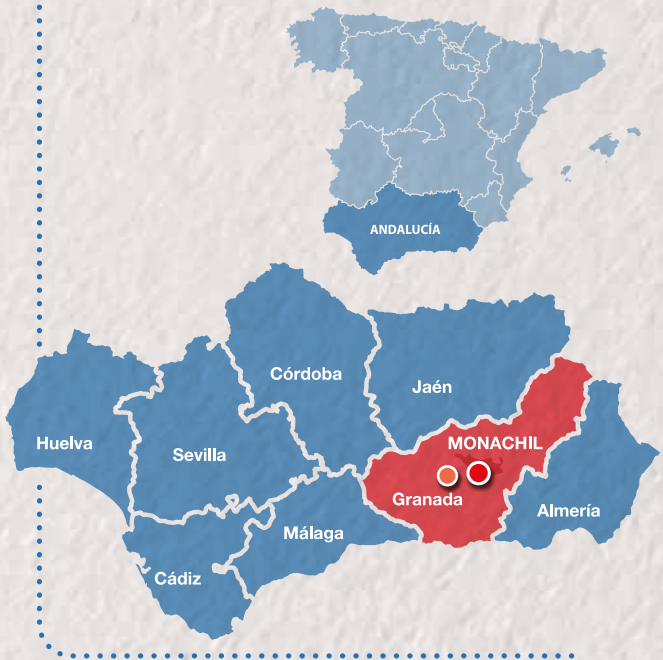

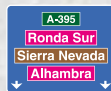




1 On the **A-44** ring road take exit number **132** towards Ronda Sur (**A-395**)

Afternoon.

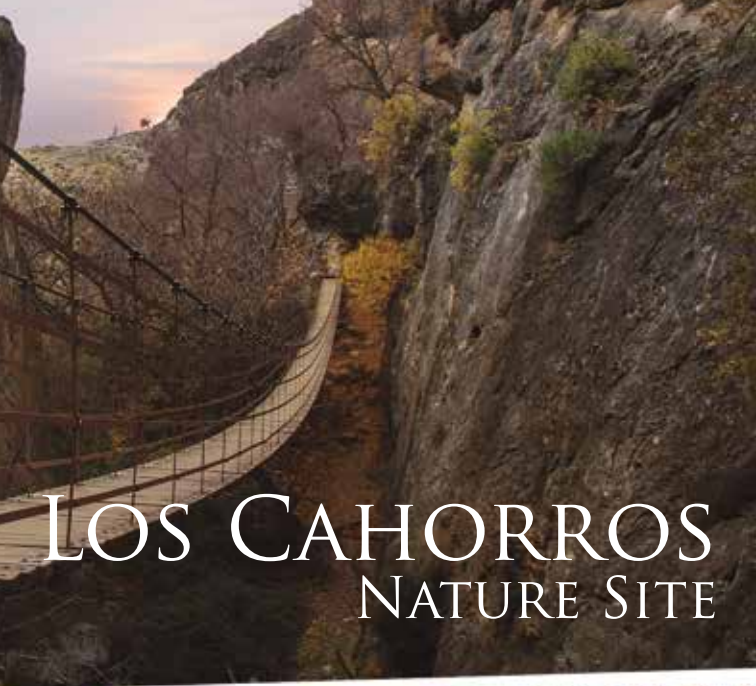

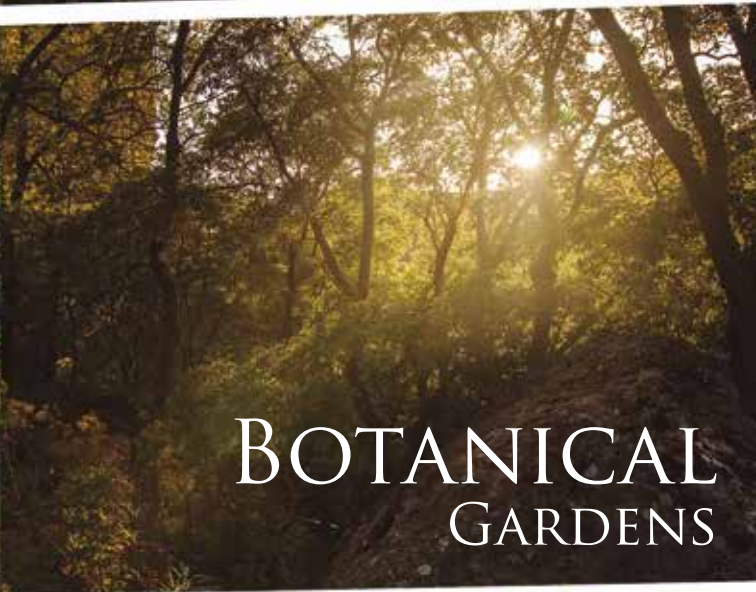

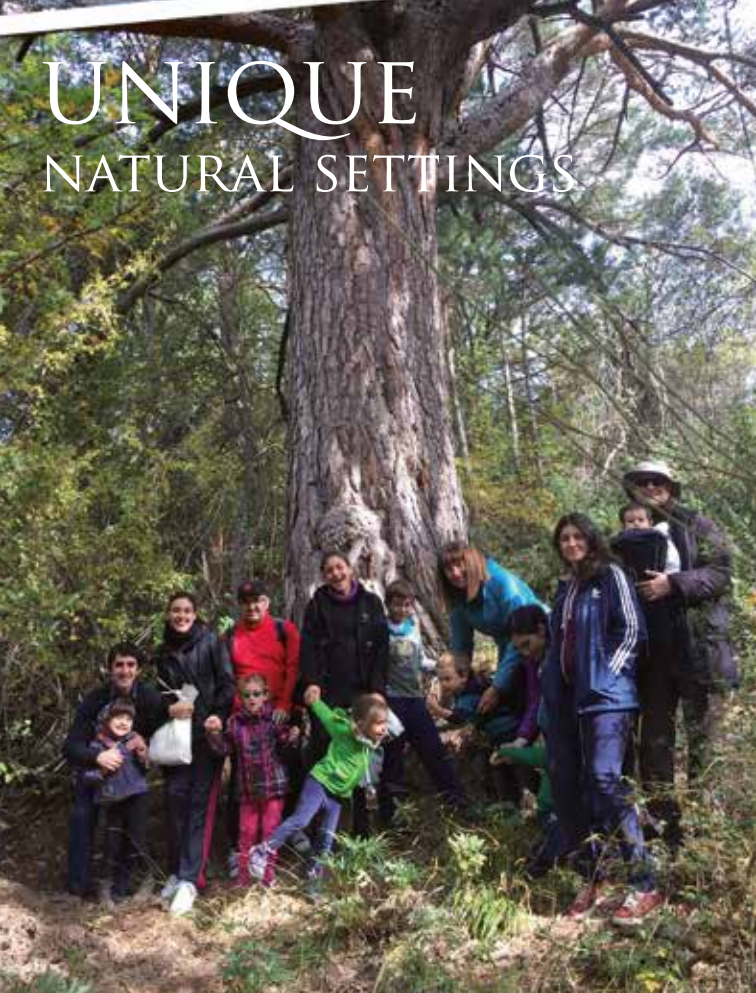
